- More than 140 people applied to be voice actors in the production

- The production recorded more than 4,000 files at Honolulu Community College's MELE studios. The final mix was done in Los Angeles with Disney's team and MELE students, contributing to their unique educational experience
- Moana has been recorded in the most number of languages ever, attesting to the movie's global appreciation
